- KFF was founded in 2003 in response to Florida's Legislature and the Department of Children and Families (DCF) initiative to privatize child welfare services.
- KFF currently employs seventy eight staff.

Building a healthier community, one family at a time.




#### **KFF Values**

- Information from families, children, support teams, and service providers will be continuously shared with the service system to ensure that interventions can be modified as needed to support positive outcomes.
- Continuous improvement of child welfare services in Clay County will be the standard and self-evaluation of the system and the use of hard data will drive decision-making.
